how can such a gentle people as we are be so murderous a prominent indonesian asks that question and the mysteries of the archipelago s vast contradictions haunt theodore friend s remarkable work a narrative of indonesia during the last half century from the postwar revolution against dutch imperialism to the unrest of today part history part meditation on a

place and a past observed firsthand indonesian destinies penetrates events that gave birth to the world's fourth largest nation and assesses the continuing dangers that threaten to tear it apart friend reveals sukarno's character through wartime collaboration with japan and suharto's through the mass murder of communists that brought him to power for thirty two years he guides our understanding of the tolerant forms of islam prevailing among the largest muslim population in the world and shows growing tensions generated by international terrorism drawing on a deep knowledge of the country's cultures its leaders and its ordinary people friend gives a human face and a sense of immediacy to the self-inflicted failures and immeasurable tragedies that cast a shadow over indonesia's past and future a clear and compelling passion shines through this richly illustrated work rarely have narrative history and personal historical witness been so seamlessly joined

the u.s. empire has relied upon an almost unimaginable loss of life from its inception during the european colonial period to the present and yet in the face of a series of endless holocausts at home and abroad the doctrine of american exceptionalism has plagued the globe for over a century in endless holocausts author david michael smith demolishes the myth of exceptionalism by demonstrating that manifold forms of mass death far from being unfortunate exceptions to an otherwise benign historical record have been indispensable in the rise of the wealthiest and most powerful imperium in the history of the world at the same time smith points to an extraordinary history of resistance by indigenous peoples people of african descent people in other nations brutalized by u.s. imperialism workers and democratic minded people around the world determined to fight for common dignity and the sake of the greater good back cover

this book is with a contemporary focus author dr max gross s purpose is to use history to explain today s islamic insurgencies in indonesia malaysia thailand and the philippines and to offer perspectives for the future muslim archipalego s unique contribution is that it brings together in one reference a mass of information on the insurgencies in southeast asia the country accounts are detailed and thorough as to events organizations dates and participants the chronological context provides dr gross the opportunity to give insights about historical casualty his accounting highlights the interaction of the insurgencies within southeast asia and their international connection outside the region the detailed presentations in the chapters on indonesia and philippines are especially fruitful included in this nearly 280 page book are detailed four color regional maps charts and historical photos spread throughout the text an extensive bibliography and index are included

a highly readable sweeping and yet detailed analysis of the african state in all its failures and moments of hope crawford young manages to touch upon all the important issues in the discipline and crucial developments in the recent history of the african continent this book will be a classic pierre englebert author of africa unity sovereignty and sorrow

this collection explores the interpretation of historical fiction through fictional representations of the past in an asian context emphasising the significance of region and locality it explores local networks of political and cultural exchanges at the heart of an asian polity the book considers how imagined pasts converge and diverge in developed and developing nations and examines the limitations of representation at a time when theories of world literature are shaping the way we interpret global histories and cultures the collection calls attention to the importance of acknowledging local tensions both within the historical and cultural make up of a country and within the asian continent in the interpretation of historical fiction it emphasizes a broad spectrum view that privileges the shared historical experiences of a group of countries in close proximity and it also responds to the paradigm shift in asian studies discussing how local conditions shape and create expectations of how we read historical fiction and working with the theme of fictionality and locality the volume provides an alternative framework for the study of world literature

southeast asia continues to beckon policymakers and scholars alike to revisit its history in spite of the tomes of appraisals already written deconstructive or otherwise because of a significant presence of muslims in the region and particularly in the wake of 9 11 it invariably attracts the attention of foreign powers drawn by the specter of terrorism and focused on rooting out radical islamist groups said to be working with al qaeda dr max gross has written an impressive account of the role of islam in the politics of southeast asia anchored by a strong historical perspective and a comprehensive treatment of current affairs the result is very much a post 9 11 book the origins of jemaah islamiyah and its connections with al qaeda are carefully detailed yet unlike much of the post 9 11 analysis of the muslim world dr gross s research has been successful in placing the phenomenon of terrorism within a larger perspective while recognizing that al qaeda s influence

on regional terror networks remains unclear it behooves us to be reminded that regardless of the nature and extent of the linkages to dismiss terrorism as a serious threat to security would be naive to the point of recklessness the muslim archipelago is a profoundly islamic region and jemaah islamiyah is only a small portion of this reality the attention dr gross pays to abim in malaysia of which i was a part and the civil islam movement in indonesia of which the late nurcholish madjid was a principal spokesman is greatly appreciated those unfamiliar with the background and role of the traditional islamic pas party in malaysia as well as the darul islam movement in indonesia will find the author's account highly beneficial the mnlf the milf and abu sayyaf in the philippines as well as the various islamic movements in southern thailand are also carefully explained

contends that the spate of retreating democracies over the past two decades is not just a series of exceptions but instead an indicator of democracy in worldwide decline in a book that looks at a number of countries as examples 10 000 first printing

since the terrorist attacks on 9 11 the political roles of religious institutions and groups have captured international attention this book examines how religious institutions and organizations in various asian countries are influencing democratic development and the shaping of government policies religious organizations and democratization covers taiwan hong kong mainland china korea thailand the philippines malaysia indonesia and japan the chapters specifically address the engagement of christian buddhist muslim and other religious organizations in the advancement and or hindrance of democratization in the region the contributors consider such questions as why have some religious organizations played a decisive role in democratic transitions while others remained politically dormant and other still acted in conservative

alliances to block democratic development why did some religious organizations that once were active and instrumental to democratic change lose their political vitality as soon as civil liberties were successfully introduced and why did other religious organizations irrespective of their roles in the process of democratic transition emerge as key political forces in the civil society

ralph bayrer s new book free people free markets their evolutionary origins is a timely reaffirmation of freedom s central role in the creation of american prosperity and the most celebrated advances of western civilization relying on the thorough scholarship and clarity of argument bayrer makes the compelling case that mankind s progress in the last millennium rests on a narrow foundation of freedom a lesson people forget at their peril this book is a compelling new perspective on economic and political history which can be expected to make a contribution to both academic and popular understanding but its most important contribution will be in helping guide current governmental decisions away from avoidable errors phillip scribner associate professor of philosophy emeritus american university

world war ii commando cold war spy and cia director under presidents nixon and ford william egan colby played a critical role in some of the most pivotal events of the twentieth century a quintessential member of the greatest generation colby embodied the moral and strategic ambiguities of the postwar world and first confronted many of the dilemmas about power and secrecy that america still grapples with today in shadow warrior eminent historian randall b woods presents a riveting biography of colby revealing that this crusader for global democracy was also drawn to the darker side of american power aiming to help reverse the spread of totalitarianism in europe and asia colby joined the u s army in 1941 just as america entered world war ii he served with distinction in france and norway and at the end of the war transitioned

into america's first peacetime intelligence agency the cia fresh from the fight against fascism colby zealously redirected his efforts against international communism he insisted on the importance of fighting communism on the ground doggedly applying guerilla tactics for counterinsurgency sabotage surveillance and information gathering on the new battlefields of the cold war over time these strategies became increasingly ruthless as head of the cia's far east division colby oversaw an endless succession of assassination attempts coups secret wars in laos and cambodia and the phoenix program in which 20 000 civilian supporters of the vietcong were killed colby ultimately came clean about many of the cia's illegal activities making public a set of internal reports known as the family jewels that haunt the agency to this day ostracized from the intelligence community he died under suspicious circumstances a murky ending to a life lived in the shadows drawing on multiple new sources including interviews with members of colby's family woods has crafted a gripping biography of one of the most fascinating and controversial figures of the twentieth century

the author of eternal vigilance presents a compelling new perspective on economic political and cultural history phillip scribner associate professor of philosophy emeritus american university adam smith the 18th century father of modern economics once posed a provocative question why do some nations prosper while others do not in free people free markets author ralph l bayrer presents the answer combining the economic theories of smith friedrich von hayek and contemporary scholarship bayrer demonstrates the vital role of freedom in the creation of prosperity in america as well as across the western world liberty free markets and scientific progress have been the all important pillars of modern progress relying on thorough scholarship and clarity of argument bayrer makes the compelling case that mankind's progress in the last millennium rests on a narrow foundation of freedom a lesson people forget at their peril john mccain

islamic extremism is the dominant security concern of many contemporary governments spanning the industrialized west to the developing world narrative landmines explores how rumors fit into and extend narrative systems and ideologies particularly in the context of terrorism counter terrorism and extremist insurgencies its concern is to foster a more sophisticated understanding of how oral and digital cultures work alongside economic diplomatic and cultural factors that influence the struggles between states and non state actors in the proverbial battle of hearts and minds beyond face to face communication the authors also address the role of new and social media in the creation and spread of rumors as narrative forms rumors are suitable to a wide range of political expression from citizens insurgents and governments alike and in places as distinct as singapore iraq and indonesia the case studies presented for analysis the authors make a compelling argument for understanding rumors in these contexts as narrative ieds low cost low tech weapons that can successfully counter such elaborate and expansive government initiatives as outreach campaigns or strategic communication efforts while not exactly the same as the advanced technological systems or improvised explosive devices to which they are metaphorically related narrative ieds nevertheless operate as weapons that can aid the extremist cause

after suharto gained power in indonesia in the mid 1960s he stayed as the country s president for more than three decades helped by the powerful military hefty foreign aid and support from a coterie of cronies a pivotal business backer for his new order government was liem sioe liong a migrant from china who arrived in java in 1938 a combination of the suharto connection serendipity and personal charm propelled him to become the wealthiest tycoon in southeast asia this is the story of how liem built the salim group a conglomerate that in its heyday controlled indonesia s largest non state

bank the country's dominant cement producer and flour mill as well as the world's biggest maker of instant noodles the book features exclusive input from Liem who died in 2012 and his youngest son Anthony Salim it traces the founder's life and the group's symbiosis with Suharto his generals and family after the tumultuous 1997-98 Asian financial crisis sparked Suharto's fall and a backlash against the strongman's cronies Anthony staved off the crushing of the debt-laden group told in a journalistic style the story of the Salim group provides insights into Suharto's New Order for business executives students and anyone with an interest in Southeast Asia's largest economy the volume makes a valuable contribution towards understanding the country's modern history

Muslim Democracy explores the relationship between politics and religion in forty-seven Muslim majority countries focusing especially on those with democratic experience such as Indonesia and Turkey and drawing comparisons with their regional non-Islamic counterparts unlike most studies of political Islam this is a politically focused book more concerned with governing realities than ideology by changing the terms of the debate from theology to politics and including the full complement of Islamic countries Schneier shows that the boundaries between church and state in the Islamic world are more variable and diverse than is commonly assumed through case studies and statistical comparisons between Muslim majority countries and their regional counterparts Muslim Democracy shows that countries with different religions but similar histories are not markedly different in their levels of democratization what many Islamists and Western observers call Islamic law moreover is more a political than a religious construct with religion more the tool than the engine of politics women who drive in Saudi Arabia as the author says are not warned they will go to hell but that they will go to jail with the political salience of religion rising in many countries this book is essential reading for students of comparative politics

religion and democratization interested in exploring the shifting boundaries between faith and politics

a sweeping account of how the sea routes of asia have transformed a vast expanse of the globe over the past five hundred years powerfully shaping the modern world in the centuries leading up to our own the volume of traffic across asian sea routes an area stretching from east africa and the middle east to japan grew dramatically eventually making them the busiest in the world the result was a massive circulation of people commodities religion culture technology and ideas in this book eric tagliacozzo chronicles how the seas and oceans of asia have shaped the history of the largest continent for the past half millennium leaving an indelible mark on the modern world in the process paying special attention to migration trade the environment and cities in asian waters examines the long history of contact between china and east africa the spread of hinduism and buddhism across the bay of bengal and the intertwined histories of islam and christianity in the philippines the book illustrates how india became central to the spice trade how the indian ocean became a british lake between the seventeenth and nineteenth centuries and how lighthouses and sea mapping played important roles in imperialism the volume ends by asking what may happen if china comes to rule the waves of asia as britain once did a novel account showing how asian history can be seen as a whole when seen from the water in asian waters presents a voyage into a past that is still alive in the present

in his view much if not all of the horror that plagued east timor in 1999 and in the 24 preceding years could have been avoided had countries like australia japan the united kingdom and especially the united states not provided indonesia with valuable political economic and military assistance as well as diplomatic cover

a riveting investigation of the jagged fault line between the christian and muslim worlds the tenth parallel the line of latitude seven hundred miles north of the equator is a geographical and ideological front line where christianity and islam collide more than half of the world s 1 3 billion muslims live along the tenth parallel so do sixty percent of the world s 2 billion christians here in the buzzing megacities and swarming jungles of africa and asia is where the two religions meet their encounter is shaping the future of each faith and of whole societies as well an award winning investigative journalist and poet eliza griswold has spent the past seven years traveling between the equator and the tenth parallel in nigeria the sudan and somalia and in indonesia malaysia and the philippines the stories she tells in the tenth parallel show us that religious conflicts are also conflicts about land water oil and other natural resources and that local and tribal issues are often shaped by religious ideas above all she makes clear that for the people she writes about one s sense of god is shaped by one s place on earth along the tenth parallel faith is geographic and demographic an urgent examination of the relationship between faith and worldly power the tenth parallel is an essential work about the conflicts over religion nationhood and natural resources that will remake the world in the years to come

for people who were poor black and from the working class growing up in a british caribbean colony during the 1900s was a very difficult experience however from about the 1930s enlightenment ideological challenges and change were finding sound footing in the area more than ever before during that time british control and exploitation of the islands were being disrupted and challenged aggressively by labor unionists and pan africanists further by the mid 1900s the british interest in and their ability to manage the islands successfully were failing at that time there was the disruptive political thrust from local labor unionists for changes in the islands story that emerging new leadership saw and promoted education as a

necessary path to the future for working class people in the islands after the author learned to read having been encouraged by an older sister he read widely from the books available and his life began to experience transformation the author noted that his love for reading plus a growing exposure to education initiated the change and inspiration beyond the limiting society and thinking into which he was born in time whitman s academic push helped him to become an educator mountain climber long distance swimmer photographer and more in all the changes which have come to the islands of st kitts and nevis he sees the local leaders push against the evils of british colonialism in time there was enlightenment and growth from education also through the love and inspiration of god those were major forces which contributed to the reformation now seen in lives and around the islands in this book my birth was not destiny the author looks back at his life in nevis and beyond he attributes his successes to focused struggles the illuminating power of education and god s continuing intent to intervene in human lives always for good dr browne also expresses a truth that his children students the community and the wider world as a result of education and careful academic concentration can in time learn grow have their own sense of a transformative experience as their lives become inspired and refashioned over time they too will reach toward the future intending to leave special markings on the sands of their time

diva rollicking adventure starring a young theodore roosevelt dividivin 1884 teddy roosevelt s political career is dead in the water a new york state assemblyman with eyes on national office he finds his ambitions thwarted just months after his wife and infant daughter pass away frustrated by politics he retires to the american west to ride ranch and hunt buffalo in the dakota badlands nobody tells him that the buffalo are gone dividiv dividivhe arrives in dakota a greenhorn awkward in the saddle and unused to western clothes but his aristocratic charm natural intelligence and love of nature impress the

hardened frontiersmen forming a bond that lasts the rest of their lives when a wealthy french marquis threatens the pristine country he has fallen in love with roosevelt joins with the dakotans to defend it before the presidency before san juan hill it was in dakota that theodore roosevelt became a man div

life is not what it seems we should be open to all possibilities of what life could be about and what life has to offer edward the main character goes through life s journey this person is a decent educated family oriented and self driven individual he is hard working and plays by the rules yet life still fails him something else out there is affecting him and telling him to wake up to something different something more beautiful life itself opens up to him because he dares to open up to the possibilities this story blends realism mysticism spirituality psychology and science together in an intriguing and inspirational plot although the book is in a fictional category it has an element of a self help non fiction genre as well dare to be reflective about the true nature of our reality dare to realize that perhaps there is more to us than first meets the eye dare to be spiritual dare to realize that our common experience is deceptive and allow yourself to open up to other possibilities dare to have the courage and wisdom to say on your death bed i have lived a full life and not say what if my life has been all wrong

imagine a world where dinosaurs survived bea and carter kingsley have been struggling to fit in at school in england after their adventures and the tragic loss of their grandmother bunty despite his misgivings about further travel their godfather theodore decides to take them to america to visit their uncle cash kingsley s ranch in california unexpectedly reunited with viscount lambert von knutr and introduced to his wife anya sitz bea and carter find themselves temporarily separated when bea accompanies the glamorous viscount s wife to san francisco theodore still determined to unlock the mysteries of

the journals the childrens father left behind takes off on a quest of his own will the rifts growing be healed or widen the adventure concludes in wild west style with a dramatic showdown at the rodeo in a world where dinosaurs have survived and evolved alongside humans bea and carter kingsley are searching for answers to the disappearance of their parents but the answers our heroes seek are surrounded in mystery what is the secret of the saurmen and who else is interested in discovering it can everyone they meet be trusted the world of supersaurs is wonderfully realized grounded in historical events and a classic storytelling adventure beautifully illustrated throughout

by examining the institutions of government through the lens of constitution making crafting constitutional democracies provides a broad and insightful introduction to comparative politics drawn from a series of lectures given in jakarta indonesia on the drafting of the u s constitution the book illustrates the problems faced by generations of founders through numerous historic and contemporary examples both indonesia in 1999 and the united states in 1789 faced the same basic issue how to construct a central government for a large and diverse nation that allowed the majority of the people to govern themselves without intruding on the rights of minorities what kinds of institutions make for good government what factors need to be considered in designing a government author edward schneier explores these questions through a rich variety of examples from both recent and historic transitions to democracy drawing frequently upon the arguments of the american federalist papers and more contemporary theories of democratization crafting constitutional democracies lucidly explores the key questions of how and why democracies succeed and fail a concluding chapter on constitutional change and decline raises provocative and important questions about the lessons that citizens of the world s older democracies might take from the struggles of the new

sultans spices and tsunamis the incredible story of the world's largest archipelago indonesia is by far the largest nation in southeast asia and has the fourth largest population in the world after the united states indonesian history and culture are especially relevant today as the island nation is an emerging power in the region with a dynamic new leader it is a land of incredible diversity and unending paradoxes that has a long and rich history stretching back a thousand years and more indonesia is the fabled spice islands of every school child's dreams one of the most colorful and fascinating countries in history these are the islands that europeans set out on countless voyages of discovery to find and later fought bitterly over in the 15th 16th and 17th centuries this was the land that christopher columbus sought and magellan actually reached and explored one tiny indonesian island was even exchanged for the island of manhattan in 1667 this fascinating history book tells the story of indonesia as a narrative of kings traders missionaries soldiers and revolutionaries featuring stormy sea crossings fiery volcanoes and the occasional tiger it recounts the colorful visits of foreign travelers who have passed through these shores for many centuries from chinese buddhist pilgrims and dutch adventurers to english sea captains and american movie stars for readers who want an entertaining introduction to asia's most fascinating country this is delightful reading

so many histories of the war in the pacific focus on the allied experience this title reverses this trend by examining the year of japanese victory when the might japanese naval and ground forces swept all before them both throughout the pacific and on mainland asia the german offensives which crushed poland in 1939 and swallowed most of western europe in less than two months in 1940 have been well documented and heavily studied however the overall picture of the remarkable japanese offensive land campaign in 1941 42 has received less attention in this fascinating book bill yenne documents the years when the imperial japanese army ija was conducting its equally unstoppable ground campaign in the far east and unlike other books on this subject he studies the campaign from the japanese point of view he reveals how the ija were able to conquer huge swathes of southeast asia in a little over eight weeks after the attack on pearl harbor using first hand accounts from japanese sources yenne reveals the tactics and mindset of the ija during their offensive detailing the capturing of manila the philippines hong kong singapore burma and the dutch east indies exploring the infrastructure and technical challenges of waging war across such a huge area yenne delves into the hardships that faced individual japanese soldiers in theatre and explains how the japanese were able to remain undefeated and establish the aura of invincibility that marked their campaign between 1941 42
