bullet riddled body of a young doctor named andrew bagby was discovered in  
keystone state park outside latrobe pennsylvania for parents dave and kate the pain

endured the chief suspect for andrew's murder was his ex girlfriend shirley turner  
obsessive and unstable shirley lied to police and fled to newfoundland before she could

she was pregnant with andrew's son zachary hoping to gain custody of the child the  
bagbys moved to newfoundland they began a drawn out court battle to protect their  
grandson from the woman who had almost certainly murdered their son then in august  
2003 shirley killed herself and the one year old zachary by jumping into the atlantic

a grief like no other is the book no one wants to ever have to buy sadly many people continue to need it from 9 11 to cindy sheehan s son from mass tragedies like the recent london bombings to law and order type crimes that make the news only to be replaced by another name as such more people are left with the aftermath of dealing with the violent death of a loved one it brings its own special brand of grieving since victim s families can spend years dealing with legal ramifications guilt and a myriad of other circumstances that don t accompany normal deaths kathleen o hara knows both sides of this coin as a therapist she has counseled hundreds of people dealing with grief as a mother she saw her worst fears realized when her college aged son was brutally

murdered in 1999 in the aftermath of aaron s murder o hara developed the seven stage journey that is at the heart of a grief like no other although this is a book for those left behind in the aftermath of violence it offers concrete and practical steps and stages allowing family and friends safe passage through this incredibly harrowing journey

over a period of several years the usaf historical division has received hundreds of requests for brief histories of air force organizations air force units ask for historical data they can use for the orientation of new personnel and for building morale and esprit de corps usaf headquarters and the commands need historical data for organizational planning information officers throughout the air force want historical materials for public relations purposes members and former members of the air force are interested in the units with which they have served government agencies and private individuals for various reasons seek information about air force units and their histories as a result of the great demand for and the interest in such histories it appeared that a book containing brief sketches of air force combat organizations would be of value as a reference work the task of preparing such a volume was undertaken by the usaf historical division as a phase of its work on world war II this book is concerned primarily with the combat or tactical groups that were active during the second world war although such groups had numerous designations nearly all fell within four major categories bombardment fighter reconnaissance and troop carrier the book covers both the combat groups that served overseas and those that remained in the united states it also covers combat organizations above the group level it does not deal with provisional organizations or with air base maintenance supply medical transport and other service or support organizations although this book is devoted exclusively to organizations that were active during world war II its coverage of those organizations is not confined to the world war II period instead each organization is traced back to its

origin and forward to 1 january 1956 with later activations being mentioned if they took place prior to the time the draft of the book was prepared in 1957 1958

on november 6 2001 dr andrew bagby was found dead in a parking lot for day use at keystone state park in derry township pennsylvania he had been shot to death there were five gunshot wounds as well as blunt force trauma to the back of the head he had been shot in both the face and chest as well as the back of the head back and buttocks he was left face down in the parking lot in his scrubs next to his toyota corolla he died there the bizarre murder case of andrew bagby entails far more than death although it has that threefold it also brought to light a woefully inept canadian legal system and the frighteningly dark mental descent of a woman scorned while evidence was steadily mounting against her dr shirley turner dropped everything left her car apartment and every worldly possession and went back to canada by the time pennsylvania had an open warrant on her she was in st john s newfoundland canada there she gave birth to andrew s son zachary while in jail she wrote to a judge against legal precedent this judge wrote her back and gave her legal advice on how to proceed with her case the united states presented evidence of her crimes and their investigation and findings thus far it was overwhelming her lies were exposed her gun casings matched and witnesses placed her car next to his at the time of the murder what happened next is one of the strangest decisions in legal history

a top crime journalist reveals precisely how the world shattering murder of john lennon happened and why in let me take you down jack jones penetrates the borderline world of dangerous fantasy in which mark david chapman stalked and killed lennon mark david chapman rose early on the morning of december 8 to make final preparations chapman had neatly arranged and left behind a curious assortment of personal items on top of the hotel dresser in an orderly semicircle he had laid out his passport an eight track tape of the music of todd rundgren his little bible open to the gospel according to john lennon he left a letter from a former ymca supervisor at fort chaffee arkansas where five years earlier he had worked with refugees from the vietnam war beside the letter were two photographs of himself surrounded by laughing vietnamese children at the center of the arrangement of personal effects he had placed the small wizard of oz poster of dorothy and the cowardly lion i woke up knowing somehow that when i left that room that was the last time i would see the room again chapman recalled i truly felt it in my bones i don t know how i had never seen john lennon up to that point i only knew that he was in the dakota but i somehow knew that it was it this was the day so i laid out on the dresser at the hotel room just a tableau of everything that was important in my life so it would say look this is me probably this is the real me this is my past and i m going gone to another place i practiced what it was going to look like when police officers came into the room it was like i was going through a door and i knew i was going to go through a door the poet s door william blake s door jim morrison s door i was leaving what i was going into a future of uncertainty praise for let me take you down jack jones has written a beautiful book rare in its attention to the social context giving rise to stalkers and assassins of celebrities celebrity worship is ambivalent admiration shares the altar with envy when the worshipped disappoints a nobody can become a somebody by killing the pop culture idol let me take you down is both fascinating and brilliant ladd wheeler professor of psychology university of rochester former president of the society for personality and social psychology
